Principals use this information to set up a religious education program at their school.  The School Education Act 1999 refers to two types of religious education that can be provided by a school:  • general religious education (GRE), a sociological-based study of major forms of religious thought and expression. Religions taught are characteristic of Australian and other societies in the world. GRE can be included in the curriculum of the school.  • Special religious education (SRE), based on distinctive religious tenets and beliefs. SRE is taught in public schools by an approved volunteer who is authorised to deliver a particular program. SRE is not part of the general curriculum. Teaching religious education in schools can help students develop respect and appreciation for cultural, social and religious diversity.  The school currently has YouthCare providing Treasure Hunters once a week during lunch time (opt in only) as SRE.
